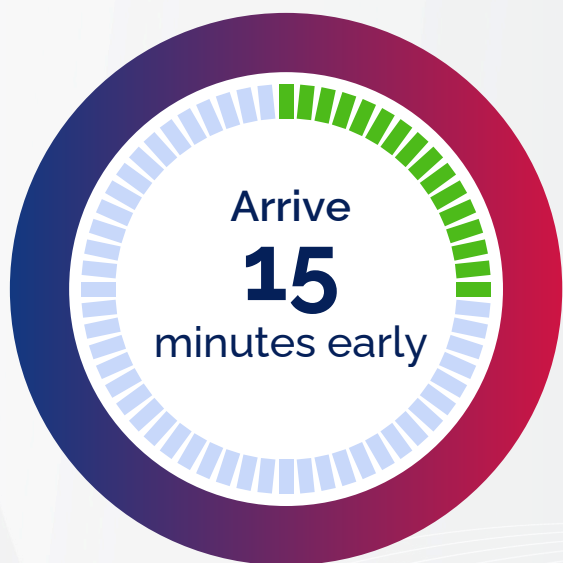

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Same Day Sick Appointments

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Transportation

Most plans include transportation through SafeRide. This service is **for non-emergency trips**, such as traveling to and from your HealthTexas appointments or specialist visits.

At HealthTexas, our clinical teams are trained to help schedule your round-trip transportation for doctor visits. If you need a wheelchair-accessible vehicle, we will make sure that request is included. If you schedule directly with SafeRide, be sure to tell them you need a wheelchair-accessible vehicle.

Please note: **SafeRide is a curb-to-curb service only** and does not provide assistance with getting in or out of the vehicle, but you may bring one adult companion with you.

Rewards FAQs

How can a patient report a completed activity? Patients can visit myUHC Medicare.com/rewards and click on "Rewards" on the right side of the home page, use the mobile app and select "Rewards," or call the number on their UCard for assistance.

Can rewards be spent online? Yes, rewards can be used online, on the UHC app, or at Walmart.com. Patients should filter by Retailer Category, choose Walmart, and enter their 17-digit UCard number at checkout. For in-person purchases, the barcode on the back of the UCard can be scanned at checkout.

Can rewards be spent on anything? No, not all items are eligible. Patients can use the Product Scanner in the UHC app to check eligibility.

Where can patients view their reward balance? Patients can view their balance and transactions on the UHC app, accessible from their home page or the rewards page.

Do rewards expire? No, reward balances do not expire and will carry over to the next year's UCard if not spent.



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Prescription & Pharmacy

Your plan may include Medicare Part D, which covers your prescriptions. You can use a local retail pharmacy for your medications. At HealthTexas, we highly recommend using OptumRx mail-order to receive your medications by mail for free.

OptumRx Mail Order Customer Service Instructions:

1. Call OptumRx customer service at (800) 791-7658.
2. Have your address, phone number, and insurance card ready.
3. Set a spending limit for your account.
4. Your doctor will call in your prescription with automatic refills electronically.
5. Your prescription will be mailed directly to your doorstep.

Medicare Prescription Payment Plan (Assistance if you can't afford your full prescription deductible, allowing you to spread payments over the year):

1. **Call Member Services:** Dial the member number on the back of your UCard.
2. **Provide Info:** Share your member ID number, name, and DOB.
3. **Payment Options:** The representative will offer payment options (no income information needed).
4. **Confirm Plan:** If you agree to a monthly payment, the representative will set up the plan and provide a payment schedule.

Note: If the representative is unfamiliar with the program or unable to assist, end the call and try again with a different representative. You must call and agree to the payment plan.

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Preferred Diabetic Supply Program

HealthTexas prescribes UHC specific diabetic glucometers and test strips to help you manage your diabetes with ease and confidence. The preferred pharmacy for diabetic meters and supplies is Optum RX. Your doctor will send the prescription directly to Optum RX, and your supplies will be conveniently delivered to you. **Below is the list of what is covered:**

Meal Benefits Post Hospital Discharge

Most plans include post-discharge meal benefits that can be used after an inpatient hospital or skilled nursing facility (SNF) stay. You can receive up to 28 home-delivered meals for up to 14 days. The first meal delivery may take up to 72 hours after ordering. There is a \$0 copay and our HealthTexas case management department will create a referral for your meals.

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Vision Services

HealthTexas partners with South Texas Total Eye Centers (STTEC) for vision exams, and no referral is needed. Patients receive one routine eye exam per year at no cost, while allowances for frames, lenses, and contacts vary by plan. **If STTEC is not selected, a referral will be required.**

All plans include preventive dental services, and some also cover 50% of comprehensive dental care. **Preventive services such as exams, routine cleanings, and X-rays have a \$0 co-pay.** Comprehensive services are covered based on an allowance from your plan and include more extensive care.

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Hearing & Hearing Device Services

Hearing services include one exam per year with a \$0 co-pay. Most plans include TWO hearing devices every year. Should you require a hearing device, co-pays start at \$199.

To schedule your hearing examination:

1. Speak with our Patient Care Representative at your clinic.
2. A Patient Care Representative will assist in locating a suitable hearing provider for you.
3. A Patient Care Representative will contact the recommended hearing location to book your appointment on your behalf.
4. Following your examination, your audiologist will assess whether you need hearing aids. If necessary, you'll be presented with various options during your examination.

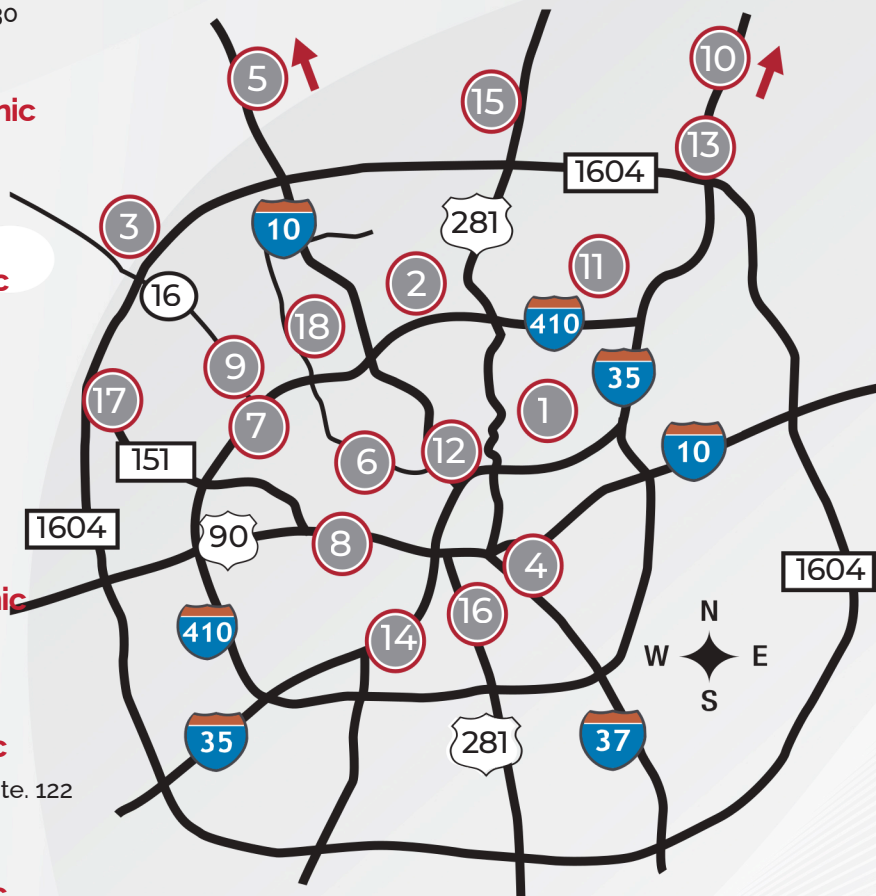
